## Terms and Conditions

- I. Rates: (These rates only reflect a portion of the actual hourly operating costs.)
  - A. First 30 minutes of chipping paid by CLRCA
  - B. Rates are \$60 per hour after the first 30 minutes
  - C. All jobs will be performed as scheduling allows
  
- II. Approved Sites:
  - A. Will be grouped by location or availability
  - B. Will be chipped at the same time as other sites in the area are chipped
  - C. Owner or resident must take their own chips (either broadcast or dumped), unless other arrangements are made with the chipper foreman on a per job basis
  
- III. Brush to be chipped must be:
  - A. Stacked perpendicular to paved road
  - B. Big end towards pavement, stacked parallel
  - C. Piles not higher than four feet
  - D. Piles not pushed by equipment
  - E. No roots or foreign material (rocks, metal, fence posts, etc.)
  
- IV. Site application must:
  - A. Have posted address
  - B. State size of pile to be chipped (example: 6' wide, 10' long, 6' high)
  
- V. Indemnification-hold harmless:

"District" shall indemnify and defend "OWNER" and hold it harmless from any and all claims, losses, damages, and liability for damages, including attorney's fees and other costs of defense incurred by "OWNER", whether for damage to or loss of property, or injury to or death of person, arising out of, or alleged to arise out of, or resulting from or in any way connected with "District's" said project.
